Now is an ideal time for green organisation "***Transition Minett*** (<http://www.transition-minett.lu/>)" to present its community garden right in the heart of Esch-sur-Alzette and the concept that comes with it of course.

Open to all in Esch and located very near to Parc Laval, the garden serves as both a space for meeting and learning. "The garden is a public place where residents and everyone can come to share and learn," explained Norry Schneider from Transition Minett, the association behind the project.

"There's a community garden. There is no plot, as this is not a project for individualists," said Schneider. In "Quartiersguart Breedewee", the public can learn about urban gardening and adapt
